Got 50 break badge for DTL (missed 75th)

I absolutely cleaned up every event this weekend except for the double barrel. But I was SOO shocked to find that I had won the handicap against so many shooters. I concentrated and I shot all of my targets with my first barrel. I almost collapsed when the man who had come second had dropped his target. This was the first ever prize I had won that was worth a lot of money. I was so happy. They moved me back from 15 meters up to 17.5 meters. I ended up shooting 216/230. The overall winner shot 225/230 so I wasn't far behind him. To think that I was shooting as good as the best shooters in Australia I was wrapped. The entire weekend it was pouring rain except for the last day. It had cleared up by then.

If anyone needs coaching I would be proud to give you some. (not bad for a SKEET shooter eh? ;)

There is a 90% chance that I will be on the cover of the November issue of the clay target shooting association magazine because of all the 13 years that this shoot was on, no junior had ever won the handicap. I made history as the first JUNIOR in 13 years to win the Griffith DTL handicap. There were over 200 shooters at the comp this year and I was up with the best of them. I am completely proud of myself and I will be back next year.

Thank you to Kathy and Elton Chetcuti for getting me this far with the junior development program. Although I do not represent Cecil park of NSW with DTL I feel as the skeet tips had helped greatly with trap as well. “

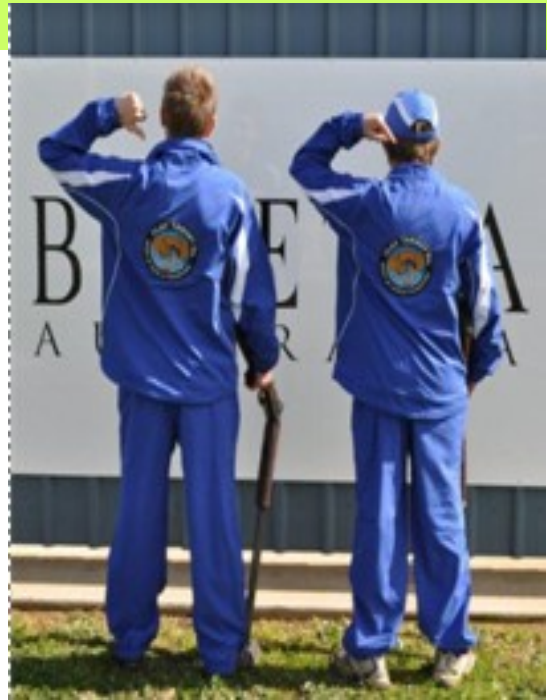

**Day 3**

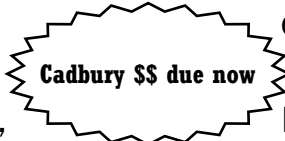
