## Josh triumphs at State Skeet Carnival

2011 State Skeet Carnival Results  
were as follows:-

Friday- 12<sup>th</sup> August 2011

#### Event 1 – NSW 20 Gauge Skeet Championship of 50 Targets

Josh shot a 49/50 which placed him  
in equal 2<sup>nd</sup> in B Grade, had to go into  
a four way shoot off, won the shoot  
off and won 2<sup>nd</sup> place in B Grade.

(Silver Medal & Cash prize)

#### Event 2 – NSW 28 Gauge Skeet Championship of 50 Targets

Josh shot a total of 46/50 missed out  
on taking a place by 1 target.

Saturday- 13<sup>th</sup> August 2011

#### Event 3 – NSW Skeet Doubles Championship of 25 Pair

Josh shot a total of 45/50 missed out on taking a place.

#### Event 4 – NSW Skeet Handicap of 50 Targets

Josh Shot 49/50 and took 5 spare lives into the shoot off. Approximately  
40 plus shooters including myself all shot well and progressed to the  
shoot off layouts. Josh Went a further 110 targets to get to be the  
“Overall State Skeet Handicap Winner” and finished with 2 spare lives.  
He also shot a 50t break in the middle of the shoot off.

(State Overall Sash & Cash prize)

At Saturdays afternoon presentation they also announced Josh had been Re-graded from B grade to A Grade “Well done”  
Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> August 2011

### Event 5 – NSW Skeet Championship of 100 Targets

Josh shot 97/100 and won the Overall Junior High Gun for this event.

(Junior High Gun Sash & Cash prize)

At Sundays afternoon presentation they announced Josh had been Re-graded again from A grade to AA Grade “Well done again”

*“he was only in A grade for 1 day”*

### State Team for Juniors

Josh Shot really well and actually qualified to shoot for the Open State Team or the Junior State Team but could only pick one Team.

Josh chose to Shoot for the Junior Team as this will be his last year at State Level as a Junior.

Josh was the Number 1 qualifier for the Junior Team and also won the Junior Team High Gun. (Junior Team High Gun Sash & Cash prize)

Josh also won the Overall High Gun over the 3 days of shooting for “B” grade.

(B Grade Overall Sash & Cash prize)

*(he was B grade at the beginning of the 1<sup>st</sup> day of competition)*

Josh shot consistently well over the 3 days of competition. His maturity and ability as a competition shooter continues to develop and grow with every competition he enters.

***He considers his biggest & best achievement over the shoot was to get to AA grade before his old man !!!***
